DAI Leadership

Robb Smith founded DAI in 2016 to teach filmmaking to small group of young people at his home church on a weekly basis. Demonstrating integrity, ethics, and respect, is high on his list regardless of the subject matter. Robb and the young students, entirely new to filmmaking, began making short films to gain real on-set experience. A number of those films went on to compete in festivals around the world.

Since then DAI has leased 5000+sf of space inside the historic Lollipops Skating center at Hwy 51 and Stateline Road. It is now a fully functioning film studio with multiple studio spaces, theater, classroom, edit bays, and all the gear needed to produce video and film projects. DAI received its 501c3 not-for-profit status in March 2019.

As the program grew, help was needed. Building the Board of Directors was accomplished by selecting those in the film industry and local community with a proven track record of integrity, stability, and a love for young people and the arts.

No Partnership Created

Use of Parties' Names

Except as otherwise provided herein, neither party may use the other party's name without approval of the other party. Each party agrees that it shall neither state nor imply, either directly or indirectly, other than under this Agreement, that it is supported, endorsed or sponsored by the other party, and upon the direction of the other party, shall issue express disclaimers to that effect.

Force Majeure

Neither party shall be responsible to the other for failure to perform any of the obligations imposed by this Agreement, provided such failure shall be occasioned by fire, flood, explosion, lightning, windstorm, earthquake, subsidence of soil, failure or destruction, in whole or part, of machinery or equipment, discontinuity in the supply of power, governmental interference, civil commotion, riot, war, strikes, labor disturbance, transportation difficulties, labor shortage, or any cause beyond the reasonable control of the party.

Termination

This agreement may be terminated by either party by providing notice to the other no less than 30 days prior to renewal. Payments made shall remain as is, with no reimbursement or refund.


